Every year Capital Region Land Conservancy (CRLC) staff visit each property for which CRLC holds or co-holds a conservation easement and has stewardship responsibility to monitor. At the time of each visit, we document our observations in a Stewardship Field Report, photograph any significant changes, and contact the property owner with any concerns or questions. We retain this information in a permanent file to document the condition of each property under easement over time. The reports are always available to the property owner upon request.

Jane Myers, Land Conservation Manager, and I completed this year's monitoring visit of Brown and Williamson Conservation Area on January 31, 2019. We were pleased to be joined by Mark Battista on our visit. Although the weather twice canceled plans to include Brown and Williamson on a day of community hikes, we appreciate the Parks and Recreation Department's commitment to making the conservation area available for public recreation.

We value the opportunity we have to play a role in Chesterfield County's efforts to preserve its open space and natural resources and to make these accessible to the community.
