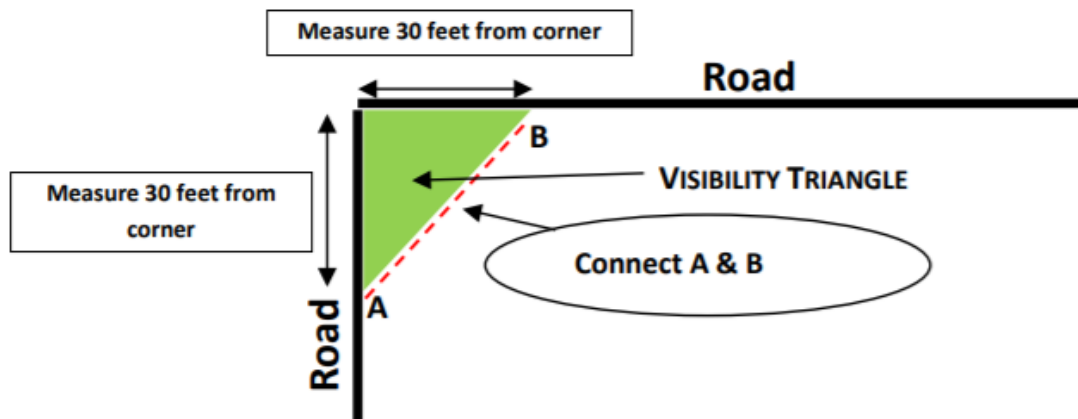


## Planting Shrubs or Trees on Your Property

When planting shrubs or trees on your property, use the Visual Triangle to make sure you do not create an obstruction and always call Miss Utility (811) before you dig.

### Visual Obstructions

1. Corner Lot. Structures or plantings which might obstruct vision between a height of 2 feet and a height of 8 feet above the established curb grade shall not be permitted within 30 feet in either direction from the corner.



2. Intersections of Drive with Road. At the intersection of a drive with a road, structures or plantings which might obstruct visibility between a height of 2 feet and 8 feet above the elevation of a driveway that is perpendicular, and adjacent to, the structure or planting within the visibility triangle. The visibility triangle is determined by measuring in two directions from the intersection of the road and the drive: 10 feet landward from the road and 10 feet parallel to the road, and then connecting the 2 points with a straight line.
