



Otterdale Road Drainage Improvement Project

Chesterfield County, VA

The County is aggressively moving forward with improving several of the drainage crossings along Otterdale Road that routinely flood and overtop the existing roadway under severe rainfall events, closing the roadway and landlocking several communities preventing ingress and egress presenting an emergency access concern. The proposed improvements will incorporate bridge structure crossings needed to pass the 100 year storm event with no overtopping for the ultimate land use conditions. In order to achieve this, the roadway profile grade will need to be raised approximately 6-7 feet at each location to prevent road closures.

- Upgrade 3 existing crossings with multi-span bridges to reduce flooding frequency.
- Each crossing will be constructed under total road closure.
- 100% Local County Funding run through the local VDOT Chesterfield Residency as a Land Use Permit.
