Dear Mr. Valdez:

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Piedmont Regional Office (PRO) has reviewed the revised plan, which was submitted as part of a minor modification request. The revision involves a revised Design Report. The revised Design Report addresses a change to the contact information, revisions to the list of acceptable waste, and clarification of operating hours. This plan has been reviewed for technical adequacy and regulatory compliance and appear to meet the requirements for Sanitary Landfills in 9 VAC 20-81-100 through 260, and the Part B Permit in 9 VAC 20-81-470.

In accordance with 9 VAC 20-81-600.F.2.c. of the Virginia Solid Waste Management Regulations (VSWMR, 9 VAC 20-81 *et seq.*), incorporation of these plans into Permit No. 604 is a minor modification requiring director approval. In order to document this modification, please incorporate a copy of this letter, its attachments, and the following documents into each copy of Permit No. 604.

Permit Attachment IV-1: Design Report – insert and replace the entire plan, last revised February 15, 2019.

As provided by Rule 2A:2 of the Supreme Court of Virginia, you have 30 days from the date of service of this decision to initiate an appeal of this decision, by filing notice with:

In the event that this decision is served to you by mail, three days are added to that period. Please refer to Part Two of the rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia, which describes the required content of the Notice of Appeal, including specification of the Circuit Court to which an appeal is taken, and additional requirements governing appeals from decisions of administrative agencies.

In accordance with 9 VAC 20-81-600.F.2.d., the permittee is required to notify the local governing body of this modification within 90 days of this letter. Dr. Joseph P. Casey, Chesterfield County Administrator, is copied on this letter to satisfy this requirement.
